§ 74.01 OBSTRUCTING TRAFFIC.

No railroad engine or train of cars shall be left standing in such a way as to obstruct any railroad crossing inside of the limits of the city for a period of time exceeding ten minutes and the conductor in charge of said train or engine, upon conviction thereof shall, for each offense, be guilty of a misdemeanor and penalized as provided in § 10.99.

§ 74.02 SPEED LIMIT.

It shall be unlawful to run any railroad engine or train through the limits of the city at a higher rate of speed than 40 miles per hour.
