

## City of Benson Economic Recovery Coordination

UMVRDC proposes to provide direct support to the commercial business community on behalf of the City of Benson to address the following:

- Recovery Resource Information Coordination & Outreach
  - Research and sharing of resources made available via federal, state and nonprofit sources for recovery.
  - Identification of recovery services to be made available on behalf of the City of Benson.
  - Identification of businesses targeted to receive services.
  - Outreach to local businesses about recovery services and information.
- Business Technical Assistance
  - Technical assistance with applications for recovery funding and support.
  - Business and financial analysis assistance/support coordinated first in conjunction with local and regional partners and alternatively directly by UMVRDC staff.

### Timeframe/Delivery:

Services would be provided directly by UMVRDC staff on a part-time basis between now and June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2020 remotely or from City offices at the discretion of the City of Benson and UMVRDC.

### Scope:

Fees will be charged according to the following:

1. Information Coordination & Outreach: The City and UMVRDC will work together to define the list of businesses for the focus of this work. Contact information will be provided by the City for each business or collected by the UMVRDC. In addition the City and UMVRDC staff will work together to refine the list of services offered to businesses and the type and frequency of the outreach. This portion of this proposal will be billed at a flat rate to be determined after the above is defined.
2. Business technical assistance will be billed on an as needed and hourly basis.

The UMVRDC has up to 300 hours available to lend toward this project at a total cost of \$24,000.
